Student Use of Technology Agreement

On-Line/Internet Services: Student Obligations and Responsibilities

- The student number, in whose name an on-line/Internet services account is issued, is responsible for its proper use at all times. An account will be issued only after the student has signed an Acceptable Use Agreement. Students shall keep personal account numbers, home addresses and telephone numbers private. They shall use the system only under their own account.
Students shall use the school's/district's system responsibly for educational purposes.
Students shall not access, post, submit, publish or display harmful or inappropriate matter that is threatening, obscene, disruptive or sexually explicit, or that could be construed as harassment or disparagement of others based on their race/ethnicity, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, religion or political beliefs.
Students shall not disclose, use or disseminate personal identification information about themselves or others when using electronic mail, chat rooms, or other forms of direct electronic communication. Personal information includes the student's name, address, telephone number, Social Security number, or other individually identifiable information.
Students shall not use the system to encourage the use of drugs, alcohol or tobacco, nor shall they promote unethical practices or any activity prohibited by law or Board policy.
Copyrighted material shall not be placed on the system without the author's permission. Students may download copyrighted material for their own use only.
Students shall not intentionally upload, download or create computer viruses and/or maliciously attempt to harm or destroy charter equipment or materials or manipulate the data of any other user, including so-called "hacking."
Students shall not read other users' electronic mail or files. They shall not attempt to interfere with other users' ability to send or receive electronic mail, nor shall they attempt to delete, copy, modify or forge other users' mail.
Students shall report any security problem or misuse of the services to the teacher or principal.

Equipment/Software: Student Obligations and Responsibilities

- Students shall not copy software owned by the Charter/District.
Students shall not download and/or install personal software on Charter/District equipment.
Students shall not connect personally owned peripheral devices to any Charter/District equipment without prior authorization by the CVC administration.
Students shall not vandalize Charter/District equipment.
Students shall follow Charter/District procedures for checking-out portable devices for educational purposes.

Inappropriate use of the Internet Electronic Information Services can result in the immediate termination of access privileges. This action can be taken without warning.

The Governing Board of Cielo Vista Charter recognizes the educational value of using Internet Electronic Information Services for communication and information access, and encourages the use of such sources to enhance student learning. The Governing Board also recognizes that access to Charter/District Internet electronic information services is a privilege and all users must agree to use the services responsibly.
